#### **National Day for Truth and Reconciliation**

## **Grade 7 Families**

We sent an email to all grade 7 families regarding the Foundation Skills Assessment (FSAs) at Centre Mountain Lellum. We provided information regarding the FSAs and reminded families that the Ministry of Education expects all children in Grades 4 and 7 to write the FSA. However, the Ministry does approve the following exceptions:

1. Students who learn in a manner significantly different from provincial curricular standards and, that is documented in their Individualized Learning Plan (IEP).

- 2. English Language Learners who are not yet proficient in reading, writing or numeracy in the English language.
- 3. Students experiencing extenuating circumstances, for example a family emergency or lengthy illness.

Families may request an exemption for one of the 3 reasons above. However, only the school principal will determine which students may be excused from participating in the FSA, based upon the criteria above.

Any family requesting an exemption from writing the FSA this year, must contact the school principal to notify which one of the 3 criteria above the student meets. Families who contact the classroom teacher to request an exemption may not be approved. This procedure will keep all the information in one place and prevent any missing requests. Thank you for your cooperation.

All requests for exemptions must be sent to the principal by Friday, Sept. 29th.
