Centre Mountain Lellum School Goals: Each year our school sets and reviews our school goals based on what we are seeing and hearing from our students. This year, our 3 goals are:

- Foster a safe, welcoming, and engaging learning environment where all students feel valued, connected, and experience a strong sense of belonging.

- 2) Strengthen students' number sense (starting with a focus on mastering multiplication/division facts).
