## Parking Drop-off/Pickup

We have now opened our lower staff parking lot and we are doing our best to keep our students safe in this area. We have asked all students to use the sidewalk in the morning and after school and asked our cycling students to walk their bikes on the sidewalk until they can safely cycle on the road. It seems to be going well in this area, but as you may know, there is a back-up heading out to Constellation Ave at the end of the day. If you are not in a rush to pick students up right after school, you may want to wait a few minutes and pick up later once the traffic is less of an issue. There will be 4 accessible parking spaces in the lower staff parking lot. Right now, we do not have any staff who need to use these accessible spaces, so if there are any families with accessibilities needs, and you need to come into the school, you are welcome to use the accessibility spaces in the lower lot. There are also some parallel parking spaces along the lower loop that you are welcome to use.

We cannot have parents park in the lower parking lot to wait for their child to be dismissed from school, but this would be a great spot to park if you are coming into the school. We are very fortunate to have these spaces available on school property.

The upper driveway and parking lot is strictly for buses and staff only. This is no space for parent parking, or for student drop-off and pick-up. We have ordered signs to be posted, so we hope these signs arrive soon.
